### 1. Introduction

Habilitative Systems, Inc. (HSI), in partnership with CP2 LLC, is seeking statements of qualifications from experienced General Contractors (GCs) for the Women Veteran and Family Supportive Housing project. This RFQ is issued in alignment with the City of Chicago's Draft Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) requirements. The project seeks a qualified GC capable of delivering a high-quality, affordable permanent supportive housing project in compliance with City, IHDA, and HUD standards.

## 2. Project Overview

This housing will provide a sanctuary of quality, safe, and affordable housing for veterans, spouses of veterans, and their families who are vulnerable to or experiencing homelessness. The team has a steering committee including women veterans who have experienced homelessness. The lead agency, Habilitative Systems, Inc. has a solid reputation for providing quality care and services to its clients. We intend to bring that informed expertise to the development and management of this housing for a most vulnerable and often overlooked segment of our military veterans.

HSI, in collaboration with CP2 LLC and other partners, is proposing the development of 27 units of permanent supportive family housing in Chicago's Austin community to address the critical need for safe and gender-specific accommodations for women veterans, spouse of a veteran, and other vulnerable women and their families on the verge of or are experiencing homelessness.

### **Funding**

The project development is City of Chicago and Low-Income Housing Tax Credits subsidized at construction to ensure affordable rents for a period no less than 15 years. Services funding will come from an expansion of existing funding. Therefore, the contractor must meet all public financing requirements.

# 3A. Preliminary Construction Budget

The total development area for the Women Veteran and Family Supportive Housing project spans approximately 35,000 square feet, divided into residential and small commercial components:

Residential Area: 30,000 square feetEstimated Construction Cost: \$325/sf
